

CE&R Team Update for FSP Board Meeting, 04/16/15

1. Several members of the FSP Board and the CE&R Team spoke at the City Council Working Session on Group Homes on 04/06/15. The City Council presented results of the work done on this subject over the last 5 months by City officials working with an external legal consulting team. These findings are not final and the City Council asked the legal team to come back with additional recommendations in a few specific areas.
2. The CE&R Team will be proceeding with their activities independently of the City of Richardson, and in consultation with HOA attorneys.
3. Work of the CE&R Team which had been on hold for a few weeks pending the outcome of City's findings, has resumed, and is now ready for legal advice. A version of the CE&R document has been put together with inputs from the entire team which will be shared with HOA attorneys for legal counsel.
4. The CE&R Team is now seeking Board approval for funds which had been previously approved by the Board. The plan is to seek 4 hours of advice from each of two law firms. (For reference the only legal expense incurred so far is \$ 1500 for previously approved 1st phase of advice from Clayton Hearn form the law firm, RWBMH).
5. Next steps after getting advice from these two firms would be to finalize the CE&R document and bring it to the Board and the HOA for approval.
